* DNB in a subject from an Institute or Medical College recognized by MCI /NMC with experience according to NMC Guidelines

In accordance with Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 reproduced as under:

"4A. Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB (Broad Specialities) with MD/MS & DNB (Super-Specialities) with DM/M.Ch.

(a) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in an institution which now runs MCI recognized postgraduate degree courses in a given subject, their DNB qualifications shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualifications in that subject only.

(b) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in a multi-speciality teaching hospital with at least 500 beds, involved in various postgraduate/super-speciality teaching programmes provided that the one out of three DNB supervisors (teachers) qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI norms in his/her previous appointment; and one out of remaining two should qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI regulations with the following bed requirement for teaching unit:

Postgraduate Broad Specialities 30 beds per unit

50% beds should be teaching beds.

Postgraduate Super Specialities 20 beds per unit

Such a qualification shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualification.

(c) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training in both Broad Specialities and Super-Specialities course in other locations/institutions (100 or more bedded hospitals) shall work for one additional year as a senior resident in a MCI recognized/permitted institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

(d) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training or after possessing DNB qualification, in both Broad Specialities and Super-Specialities course from an institution not covered in sub-clauses (a) to (c) shall work for two additional years as Sr. Resident/Research Associate (CSIR) in an MCI recognised/permitted medical college/institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

UPPER AGE LIMIT: 45 years as on 25th July 2024.

1. For eligibility to apply for these posts upper age limit as on last date of application will be 45 years. This is relaxable for SC/ ST candidate for a maximum period of Five years. In the case of OBC candidates it is relaxable upto a maximum period of Three years. For PwBD candidates, the age is relaxable for 10 years for UR; for 13 years for OBC and for 15 years for SC/ST.
2. To be eligible for selection for these posts, the candidate should have passed the qualifying examination before the date of Interview & result declared to this effect on or before this date.
3. The candidates who are in service/under bond in any Government Institutions are required to submit No Objection Certificate from the employer at the time of Interview. The candidates will not be permitted for Interview if they fail to produce no objection certificate on the day of interview during scrutiny of documents.
4. Appearance in Interview does not entitle a candidate for selection.

NOTE: Payment should be made online only and the application fee once remitted shall not be refunded.

PAY SCALE: ₹ 18,750 + 6,600 (Grade Pay) + NPA (Non Practicing Allowance) plus other usual allowance or revised pay scale as per 7th CPC as applicable (Level – 11 of the Matrix (Pre-revised PB – 3, entry pay of the ₹ 67,700/- per month + NPA plus other usual allowance admissible under rules).

The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree and tenure by **25.07.2024**. The candidates who are likely to complete their requisite qualification, degree and tenure after 25.07.2024 will not eligible to appear in this examination.

COURSE FEES: Selected candidate has to pay the following fees on the day of admission:-

BOND: Candidates selected for Post-Doctoral Fellowship will execute a bond of ₹ 2,00,000/- (Two Lakh Rupees Only) on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of ₹ 100/- along with 2 sureties.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Eligible applicants will be notified to appear in an exam (MCQs based) followed by an Interview. Shortlisting of candidates will be done in ratio of 1:6 per vacancy, according to marks obtained in the exam.

A candidate is allowed to submit application for both the PDCC courses.
