A brief of discussions and decisions in the meeting is as follows:

1. SFC 01/01: Welcome to the Chairman by the Member Secretary

Prof. (Col.) Dr. CDS Katoch, Executive Director AIIMS Rajkot and Member Secretary welcomed Shri Rajesh Bhushan, Union Health Secretary and requested him to Chair the first meeting of the Standing Finance Committee of AIIMS Rajkot.

2. SFC 01/02: Address by the Chairman Standing Finance Committee of AIIMS Rajkot

Shri Rajesh Bhushan, Union Health Secretary and Chairman, Standing Finance Committee welcomed all members to the first meeting of SFC of AIIMS Rajkot. He emphasized on the importance of SFC and outlined as to how it helps the Administrative Ministry in supervising establishment of new AIIMS like AIIMS Rajko. These meetings bring to fore issues which are important for establishment of new AIIMS. They also highlight hinderances which are required to be addressed during the establishment process as well as operationalization of AIIMS like institution.

He thereafter requested the Member Secretary to take up agenda items.

3. SFC 01/03: Presentation of Budget expenses of FY 2019-20 (part year) by the Finance Officer of the Institute

The Member Secretary presented the budget expenses of the financial year 2020-21 through the Finance Officer of the Institute [Deputy Director (Administration)]. The SFC considered and approved the expenses reflected in the financial statement for further process towards Statutory audit.

4. SFC 01/04: Presentation of Budget Estimates for the FY 2022-23 and Revised Estimates for the FY 2021-22 for consideration and recommendations

SFC 01/04 A: Summary Chart Showing RE for FY 2021-22

AIIMS Rajkot has requested for Rs. 12 Crores under GIA-General; Rs. 8 Crore under GIA-Capital and Rs. 19 Crores under GIA-Salaries. Chairman invite views of Joint Secretary and thereafter Additional Secretary and Financial Advisor MoHFW, as well as all other members. After due deliberation, the SFC approved following amounts under RE for financial year 2021-22 with stipulation that in case of exhaustion/likely exhaustion of funds, AIIMS Rajkot will be free to request supplementary funds in January 2022.

5. SFC 01/05: Approval of ratification/adoption of OM/Circulars issued by administrative Ministry/Government of India in AIIMS Rajkot
01/05/a: (i) Ratification of adoption of scheme of revision of pay of teachers and equivalent cadres in universities and colleges following the revision of pay scales of Central Government employees on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) and

(ii) Ratification of extension of benefits of pay revision and allowance as per 7th CPC in accordance with the MOH&FW letters dated 23rd August 2018, No.V-16020/28/2017-INI-(Pt.).

Decision of SFC: The SFC considered and ratified the extension of benefits of pay revision and allowance as per 7th CPC in accordance with the MOH&FW letters dated 23rd August 2018, No. V-16020/28/2017-INI-1 (Pt.)

- a. **01/05/b:** Approval of adoption of OM dated 09.07.2021 of the administrative Ministry for grant of Stipend for the MBBS students during rotatory internship at AIIMS Rajkot

Decision of SFC:The SFC approved the adoption of OM dated 09.07.2021 of the administrative Ministry for grant of Stipend for the MBBS students during rotatory internship at AIIMS Rajkot with the remarks that this will be applicable only in future when MBBS students of AIIMS Rajkot commence their internship.

01/05/c: Grant of Academic Allowance to Faculty, including Executive Director, who is also officiating as a faculty in the department of Pulmonary Medicine, at par with other AIIMS and in accordance with the Ministry OMs dated 1st November 2017 and 23rd August 2018.

Decision of SFC :The SFC considered and ratified the adoption of said OM dated 1st November 2017 and 23rd August 2018, on grant of Academic Allowance to all Faculty and also approved grant of academic allowance to the Executive Director of AIIMS Rajkot.

01/05/d: Grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance (HPCA)/Patient Care Allowance (PCA) to Group "A" & "B" (Non-ministerial employees), allied Healthcare Professionals (with arrears working in AIIMS Rajkot according to the orders and OM of MoH&FW dated 18.09.2019.

Decision of SFC:The SFC considered and ratified the adoption of OM dated 18.09.2019 of MoH&FW for Grant of Hospital Patient Care Allowance (HPCA)/Patient Care Allowance (PCA) to Group "A" & "B" (Non-ministerial employees), allied Healthcare Professionals working in AIIMS Rajkot.

01/05/e: Adoption of OM from MoH&FW dated 16th June 2017 on remuneration to Guest Faculty/ Technical Experts and sitting fee in respect of non-Officials

Decision of SFC:The SFC considered and ratified the adoption of said OM from MoH&FW dated 16th June 2017 on remuneration to Guest Faculty/ Technical Experts and sitting fee in respect of non-Officials, as proposed.

01/05/f: Enhanced NPS contributions

- i. **Enhanced NPS contribution for employees of AIIMS Rajkot:** Grant of New Pension Scheme (NPS) contribution at 14% to the employees of AIIMS Rajkot at par with the contribution by the Central Government

Decision of SFC :The Union Health Secretary informed about efforts undertaken by administrative Ministry towards this important matter of employee welfare. Due to continuous persuasion, the Department of Expenditure has agreed to approve the extension of employers NPS contribution from existing 10% to 14% with retrospective effect for employees of central autonomous bodies like AIIMS at par with the central government employees. The SFC considered and approved the enhancement of employer NPS

contribution from existing 10% to 14% in accordance with the recent OM from Department of Expenditure wherein such enhancement has been recommended for all central autonomous bodies.

(ii)Enhanced NPS contribution for Deputationist on Foreign Service Terms: Adoption of DoPT OM dated 09/10/2020 on pension contribution at 28% (10 % by Employee; 14% by Employer; additional 4% by employer) for Deputationists on Foreign Service Terms in AIIMS Rajkot as a borrowing organization

Decision of SFC : The SFC considered and approved the adoption of DOP&T OM DoPT OM dated 09/10/2020 on pension contribution at 28% (10 % by Employee; 14% by Employer; additional 4% by employer) for Deputationists on Foreign Service Terms in AIIMS Rajkot as a borrowing organization.

On the matter of grant of enhanced NPS contribution to the current DD(A), AIIMS Rajkot, the SFC advised that individual issue concerning Deputy Director (Admin) may be separately sent for consideration of Administrative Ministry.

01/05/g: Ratification of the adoption of OM of the administrative Ministry on Delegation of financial powers to the Executive Director of the Institute (Various OMs/Circulars)

Decision of SFC :The Chairman remarked that this is a very important matter. After deliberations, the SFC ratified the adoption and exercise of all financial powers by the Executive Director, AIIMS Rajkot in accordance with the delegation of financial power extended to the Directors of other new AIIMS.

01/05/h: Ratification of LRA to Faculty and Non-faculty in accordance with the circular of administrative Ministry dated 05.07.2017. The items for LRA may be permitted as per the List approved by the Standing Academic committee (1st SAC) of AIIMS Rajkot.

Decision of SFC :The SFC made following observations while ratifying the adoption of OM dated 05.07.2017of Administrative Ministry for AIIMS Rajkot –

1. The SFC instructed the Executive Director to evaluate the utilization of the items procured by faculty members from the LRA grant from time to time and an assessment report may be put up to the next SFC.
2. The SFC approved the list of items proposed by SAC subject to periodic evaluation by the Executive Director.
3. The SFC permitted provision of LRA to Executive Director as per the practice in other new AIIMS equivalent to faculty members.
4. The SFC approved the view of the AS & FA that LRA will only be a proportionate grant for the period the faculty served in the institution.

SFC 01/06: Presentation of other financial-matters pertaining to the Institute

- a. SFC 01/06/A: MoU of AIIMS Rajkot with M/s HLL HITES to act as Procurement Support Agency in procurement of medical equipment

Decision of SFC : The SFC approved MoU of AIIMS Rajkot with M/s HLL HITES act as Procurement Support Agency in procurement of medical equipment. With regard to the DPR equipment procurement, the Union Health Secretary emphasized that : closely monitored equipment delivery schedule and synchronization needs to be ensured by AIIMS Rajkot. The synchronization between construction and equipment delivery should ensure that there are no undue modifications of the civil works, and that there is coordination between provision of site readiness certificate and supply of medical equipment.

- b. SFC 01/06/B: Approval of MoU of AIIMS Rajkot with HLL AMRIT to open a Pharmacy Shop in the AIIMS premises for provision of drugs, consumables and implants at affordable economical rates, and to act as Nodal agency for PMJAY patients, as and when IPD begins and enrollment of AIIMS Rajkot under Ayushman Bharat Yojna is operational.

Decision of SFC : The SFC approved the proposed MoU of AIIMS Rajkot with HLL AMRIT to open a Pharmacy Shop in the AIIMS premises for provision of drug consumables and implants at affordable economical rates, and to act as Nodal agency for PMJAY patients, as and when IPD begins and enrollment of AIIMS Rajkot under Ayushman Bharat Yojna is operational, as proposed by AIIMS Rajkot in their agenda notes.

- c. SFC 01/06/C: Approval of proposed MoU of AIIMS Rajkot with BSNL to provide Internet Lease Line to AIIMS Rajkot in line with the OM dated 12th October 2020 of the Ministry of Communications, Government of India and OM dated 04/09/2019 of Ministry of Finance

Decision of SFC : The permanent campus requires an Internet lease line to facilitate multiple academic, administrative and clinical work. In accordance with the OM dated 12th October 2020 of the Ministry of Communications, Government of India and OM dated 04/09/2019 of Ministry of Finance, regarding mandatory use of BSNL facilities, AIIMS Rajkot has approached BSNL Rajkot for a financial proposal which was received. After due diligence, AIIMS has issued a work-order for initial setup of Internet lease line. In due course MoU between AIIMS Rajkot and BSNL will be done. BSNL has started the works to provide Internet Lease Line to AIIMS Campus in Khandheri in order to provide uninterrupted internet connectivity of an adequate broad band by December 2021, so as to facilitate commencement of OPD. The SFC approved the proposed arrangements between AIIMS Rajkot and the BSNL.

- d. SFC 01/06/D: Approval of proposed MoU with M/s CDAC under the MeITy, Government of India for provision of HMIS and related IT application services in AIIMS Rajkot.

Decision of SFC :The SFC while deliberating on the proposed MoU between AIIMS Rajkot and M/s CDAC also observed that Ministry has also decided to consider any other HMIS which have been successfully implemented in any other Government hospitals, in addition to CDAC and NIC applications. The SF thereafter approved the proposed MoU between AIIMS Rajkot and CDAC, as proposed.

- e. SFC 01/06/E: Ratification of adoption of Fee structure for MBBS students in accordance with the fee structure of AIIMS New Delhi

Decision of SFC :The SFC approved the fee structure adopted in AIIMS Rajkot is as follows:

- ii. Extension of the extension of Health benefit scheme of employees to the SR/JR/Tutors and full-time regular students of AIIMS Rajkot, in accordance with the practice in other established AIIMS
- i. Ratification of adoption of Employee Health Scheme for employees of AIIMS Rajkot in line with CGHS contributory scheme till the in-house facilities are established.

Decision of SFC :The SFC approved the proposal of extension of medical facilities for employees and residents who are either permanent or temporary employees of AIIMS Rajkot. The AS & FA pointed out that the CS(MA) rules are not applicable to anyone other than permanent or temporary employees and as such cannot be extended to the MBBS students of AIIMS Rajkot. The SFC directed AIIMS Rajkot put up references in this regard to the Administrative Ministry. While approving the extension of CS(MA) facilities to the employees, the SFC instructed that such facilities will be applicable till such time the hospital facilities in AIIMS Rajkot are established.

- g. SFC 01/06/G: Ratification of temporary arrangements made for operationalization of temporary campus in December 2020 by adopting work-orders/ rate contracts of the PDU medical College & the Government of Gujarat for selection of vendor for manpower, including security and housekeeping services, and operational vehicles.

Decision of SFC During deliberations, the Chairman SFC invited comments from the ACS Health and Family Welfare, Government of Gujarat on essentiality of expenditure. After due deliberation, the SFC approved the expenditure incurred on operationalization of temporary campus from December 2020. The SFC noted the arrangements made for manpower, security, housekeeping services and hiring of operational vehicles by adopting work orders/rate contracts of the PDU medical college and the Government of Gujarat.

- h. SFC 01/06/H: Ratification of expenses done in connection with the

a. Inauguration of First Academic Session of AIIMS Rajkot chaired by Hon. HFM of India and Hon. CM of Gujarat

- b. Foundation Stone Laying ceremony by the Honorable Prime Minister of India from the Project Fund of the Institute through HSCC.

Decision of SFC After deliberations, the SFC approved the expenditure incurred from project fund for Foundation Stone Laying ceremony by the Honorable Prime Minister of India from the Project Fund of the Institute through HSCC. The SF also noted the expenditure incurred on inauguration of First Academic Session of AIIMS Rajkot chaired by Hon. HFM of India and Hon. CM of Gujarat.

- i. SFC 01/06/I: Ratification of expenses on Hiring of accommodation for the Executive Director, AIIMS Rajkot

Decision of SFC :The SFC instructed AIIMS Rajkot to obtain a fair rent value of the residential quarter hired for the Executive Director AIIMS Rajkot. This can be done either by referring the issue to CPWD or through Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the area. The SFC also remarked that till such time reference is received, the rent being paid shall remain approved on post facto basis.

- j. SFC 01/06/J: Ratification of opening of Bank Accounts in accordance with AIIMS Regulations (SBI or Nationalized Banks)

Decision of SFC : The SFC noted the above information.

- i. SFC 01/06/k: Approval for appointment of Retired Government/Ex-Army officers as Consultants in AIIMS Rajkot on Last pay less pension basis to tide over lack of domain specialists in Administration, establishment, recruitment, Finance, Stores, Legal, Secretarial staff, etc.; and in accordance with existing practices in other AIIMS.

Decision of SFC : AIIMS Rajkot has proposed to appoint Consultant (Admin), Consultan (Finance), Consultant (Establishment), Consultant (Law), Consultant (Rajbhasha), Consultan (Procurement), Consultant (IT) and Consultant (PRO and Co-ordination). The SFC deliberate on this issue and approved appointment of Retired Government/Ex-Army officers as

Consultants in AIIMS Rajkot on Last pay less pension basis to tide over lack of domain specialists in Administration, establishment, recruitment, Finance, Stores, Legal, Secretaria staff, etc.; and in accordance with existing practices in MoHFW and in other AIIMS. The SF noted appointment of Consultant (Administration) and Consultant (Finance) in AIIMS Rajkot on last pay less pension basis.

While deliberating on non-availability of regular manpower despite multiple efforts by AIIMS Rajkot, the SFC advised AIIMS Rajkot to regularly coordinate with the Institute Board members and the senior officers in the Government of Gujarat.

L. SFC 01/06/L: Approval of adoption of CGHS (Delhi) Rates for OPD at AIIMS Rajkot, except for the visit charges.

Decision of SFC AIIMS Rajkot is commencing the OPD Services. It is proposed to adopt the CGHS (Delhi) Rates for diagnostic and Lab services. The visiting charges will be NIL, except for the charge of Patient-Booklet Card, which is a one time-levy, of approximate Rs. 10/- per Booklet. The SFC deliberated and approved the proposal.

- j. SFC 01/06/M: Approval of adoption of OM of AIIMS Delhi on conferences, seminars, etc. within and outside India for Faculty Members

Decision of SFC AIIMS Delhi has formulated a system of 'on-duty headquarter leave', christened as 'Academic leave' permissible to faculty for the purposes of attending conferences, seminars, invigilation duties, etc. in India and abroad. All AIIMS have adopted the OM of AIIMS Delhi in this regard. The current OM was issued in 2015. AIIMS Rajkot proposes to adopt the OM dated 17.10.2015 of AIIMS Delhi Annexure SFC 01/06/M along with the stated financial implications of tours, travels and foreign visits. The SAC of AIIMS Rajkot has granted in-principle approval to place the agenda before the SFC of AIIMS Rajkot for their consideration. The SFC deliberated and approved the proposal.

- k. SFC 01/06/N: Approval of remuneration for various activities (academic/ examination) at AIIMS Rajkot

Decision of SFC The SFC deliberated and approved adoption of AIIMS Delhi rates in AIIMS Rajkot for various academic/examination activities.

- l. SFC 01/06/O: Approval of grant for Intramural Research in AIIMS Rajkot

Decision of SFC The SFC considered and approved the proposal of grant of Intramural Research Grant up to Rs. 5 Lakhs subject to adherence to guidelines approved by the SAC with observation that it should be in accordance with AIIMS New Delhi guideline and practices.

- m. SFC 01/06/P: Ratification of pay-fixation and drawal of pay concurrently with and over and above pension in the case of the Executive Director, AIIMS Rajkot appointed on contract basis in accordance with orders of administrative Ministry dated 15.03.2021 and relevant DoPT OMs.

Decision of SFC The SFC deliberated on the issue and instructed that a reference may be

sent to administrative ministry on this matter.

- n. SFC 01/06/Q: Approval of Free Generic medicine (Through HLL AMRIT) to the OPD patients of AIIMS Rajkot in accordance with the erstwhile practice in AIIMS New Delhi.

Decision of SFC :The SFC after deliberations directed that a suitable reference may be sent to administrative ministry on this issue.

SFC/01/7/: Any other matter with the approval of Chair

Table Agenda 1 : Additional grant of Rs. 3.77 Crores from project funds towards boundary wall pre-construction cost due to site conditions.

The pre-construction work for construction of boundary in AIIMS Rajkot has been awarded to HITES (Construction Division) for an estimate of around Rs. 7.71 crores. Due to water logging, and on account of location of AIIMS site near a water body, which is fed by discharge from the Rajkot city, it was discovered during construction that the proposed pre-fabricated wall may not withstand the pressure of water from the adjoining water body and may break down.

Hence in consultation with their Head Office, HITES sent a proposal to IIT Chennai. After technical vetting, IIT Chennai has proposed construction of retaining wall of variable heights to contain the inflow of water from water body into the campus at a cost of about Rs 4.54 Crores. After consideration of savings, the additional cost implication amounts to Rs. 3.77 Crores. It is pertinent to mention that the DPR budget for pre-construction in AIIMS Rajkot about Rs. 15 crores. The existing tender of HITES (Construction Division) is of about Rs. 7.7 crores. Upon consideration of additional outlay on construction of retaining wall, of about Rs. 3.77 crores, overall cost comes to 11.48 Crores. The total amount is within the sanctioned budget of Rs. 15 crores.

The pre-construction work for AIIMS Rajkot has been assigned by the Administrative Ministry to HITES (Construction Division). The alternate additional work may also be assigned to HITES, if approved by the SFC.

Decision of SFC :After due deliberations, the SFC instructed that a detailed proposal from HITES should be obtained and submitted to administrative ministry for examination and decision.

SFC/01/08: Vote of Thanks by Member Secretary

The Member Secretary thanked the chairperson and members of Standing Finance Committee, as well as the Joint Secretary, PMSSY and other attendees for their valuable time and guidance towards establishment of AIIMS Rajkot.
